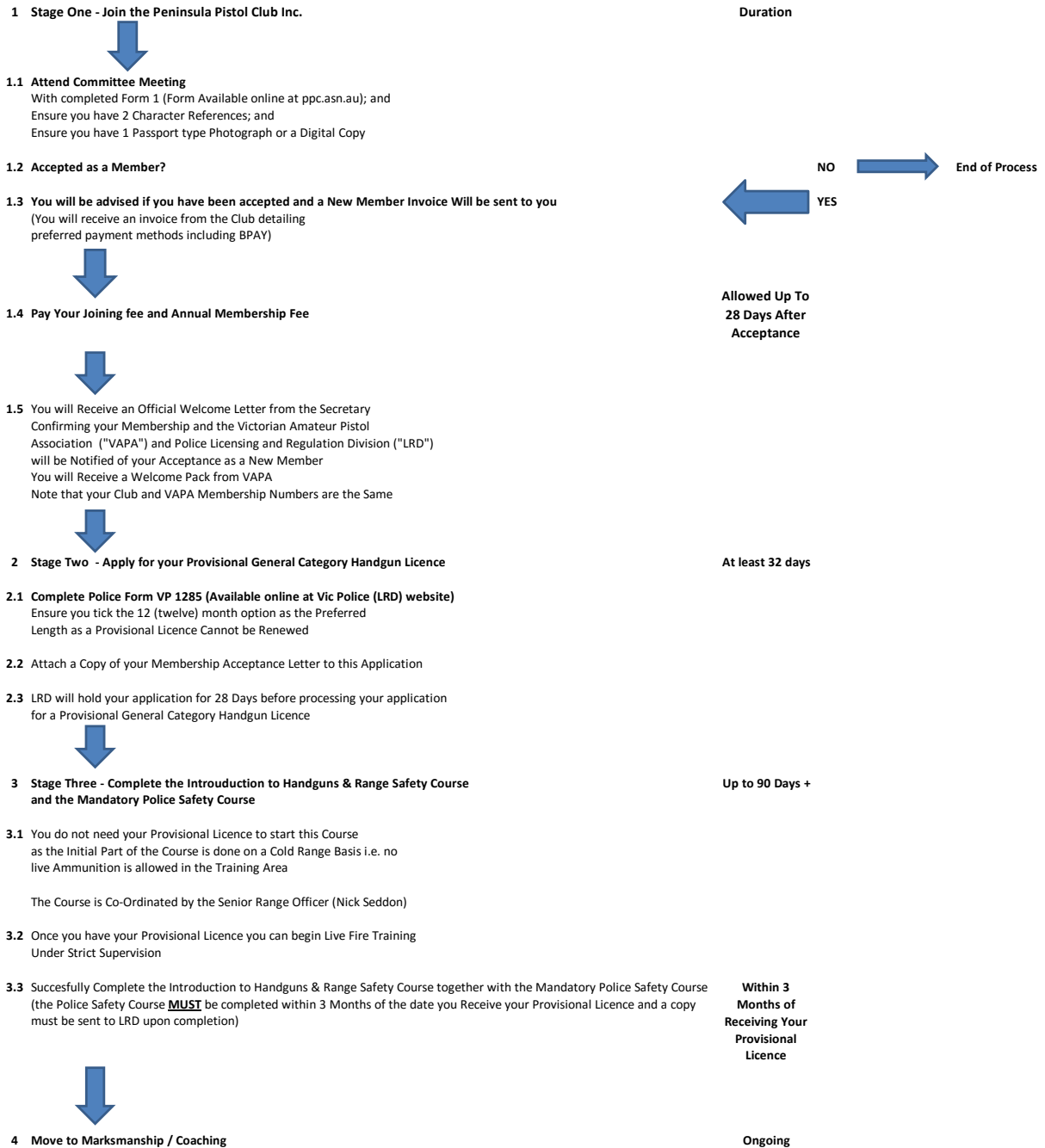

5 Apply for your Full Handgun Licence (Form available at Vic Police (LRD) website)

**At least 6
Months After
Joining the Club**

- 5.1 You can Apply for your Full Handgun Licence After Being a Member of the Club for 6 Months and have Competed in at least 5 Matches
- 5.2 Arrange for your Fingerprints to be Taken and a National Police Records Check to be Performed - call 1300 881 596 to arrange this
- 5.3 Ensure you Attach a COPY of your Mandatory Police Safety Course Certificate to your Application for a Full Handgun Licence
- 5.4 Complete Club Forms 2 and 2A (Available at ppc.asn.au)
- 5.5 Once you Have the Details at 5.2 Above Complete Police Form VP0304B (Form available at Vic Police (LRD) website) LRD will hold your application for 28 Days before processing your application for a Full Handgun Licence
- 5.6 Receive your Full Handgun Licence



6 Apply for Your First Permit to Acquire a Handgun

- 6.1 Complete Police Form 0337B and Club Forms 2 and 2A (Forms available at ppc.asn.au and Vic Police (LRD) websites) LRD will hold your application for 28 Days before processing your application
- 6.2 Remember the Restrictions on the Type and Number of Firearms you can Acquire within 6 Months of Receiving your Full Handgun Licence



7 After Holding a Full Handgun Licence for 12 Months

- 7.1 Apply for Further Permits to Acquire for Handguns Appropriate to the Matches you wish to Participate in.
- 7.2 Complete Police Form 0337B and Club Form 2 (Forms Available at ppc.asn.au and Vic Police (LRD) websites)

The Whole Process can take 18 Months if You Fully Use the 12 Month Time on Your Provisional Licence
